The mission of DNLCC is to keep children safe from abuse and when abuse occurs, to work with our community to bring healing to these children and their families. DNLCC delivers and coordinates services for victims and their families in a child-friendly, child-focused environment. By working with over 40 agencies in the community, DNLCC provides a coordinated response to any allegation of abuse. The services available at DNLCC include:

- **Assessments** by trained mental health professionals to determine what has happened to raise the concern about abuse
- **Medical examinations** through a partnership with MUSC to establish the physical health of each child
- **Individual therapy** for children and **group therapy** for both children and non-offending adults
- **Coordination of other services** provided by partner agencies





What a terrific surprise and pleasure to receive the additional funds from the IOP Run/Walk. This is an unexpected and much-needed addition to the generous contribution you have already made. Thank you for all the hard work you invest annually in the run to help charities in our community. We are also deeply grateful to the sponsors who make all this possible.

I thought you would be interested in the story of the young man who "graduated" from Windwood Farm a few years ago and spoke during the breakfast. At the age of eight, Tony came to the United States from Central American where he had been the victim of sexual abuse by a clergyman. In America, he was physically abused by his step-father. After placement in several shelters and foster homes, his aggressive, defiant behavior and criminal actions landed this boy at Windwood Farm at the age of 13. And then, his life changed forever.

To hear this articulate, well-mannered young man speak today, it is hard to believe he is the same person who couldn't speak English when he arrived in America and was placed at Windwood Farm three years ago because he was so troubled and in so much trouble. But that is the "magic" and deep value of the treatment provided here.

At Windwood Farm we believe that helping children is an investment and a legacy - our message of hope to the future. Your help in restoring hope to the lives of young people, like Tony, who have lost hope is significant and meaningful.
